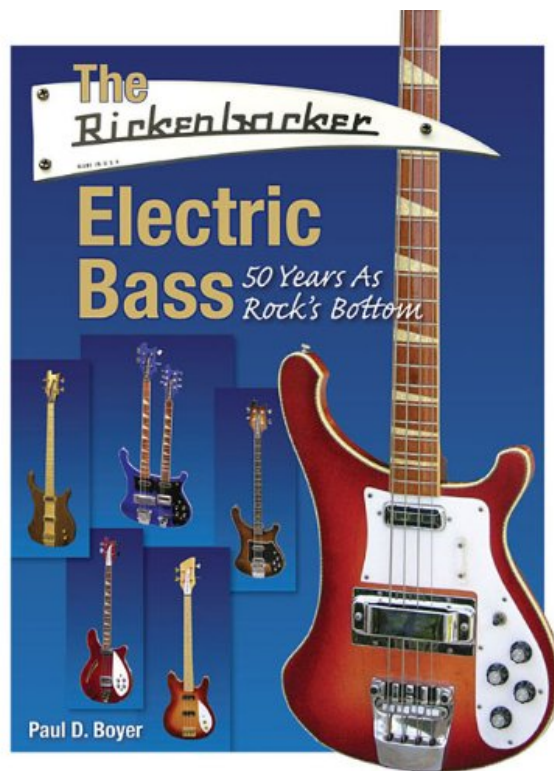
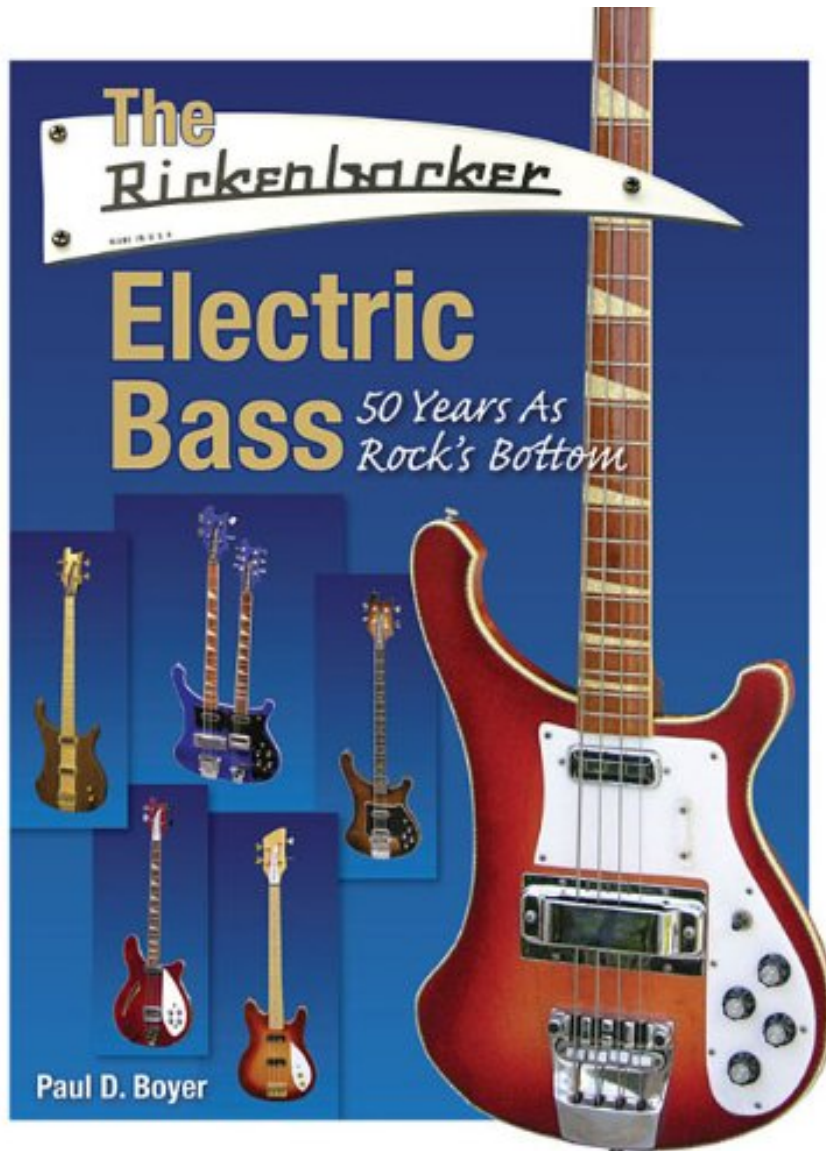

I've loved the sound of Rickenbacker basses since I first heard Chris Squire in about 1970. Didn't get my own 1st one (a '71 4001 MG, w/"toaster", checkerboard binding and skunk stripe - damn, I sure I wish I could get that one back!) until 1981. But to my knowledge, there's never before been a one-stop source for the complete story regarding their history, development, evolution, etc. For anyone who is interested in what is beyond doubt one of the most iconic instruments in the history of rock music, this is the book for you. It's all here, in detail - the various model families; their similarities and differences; the incremental improvements (incl. production dates - invaluable if you're looking for one that has certain characteristics.)
